- ✓ Respect your Instructor/coach and those from other clubs or organisations
- ✓ Respect and celebrate difference and never discriminate against anyone else on the grounds of gender, race, sexual orientation or ability
- ✓ Report any incidents of bullying, including homophobia and transphobia even if you are just a witness

- ✓ Be respected and treated fairly by us

- ✓ Be encouraged and develop skills with our help
- ✓ Be looked after in the event of an accident and have your next of kin informed if necessary
